Enrollment Guidelines: To be admitted to a technical program at the Career Center, a **junior** must have earned at least six credits in the state required core areas. These must include at least one credit in each of the following: English, Math, Science and Social Studies.

To be admitted to a technical program at the Career Center, a **senior** must have earned a minimum of twelve credits, nine in the required core areas. At least two of the credits must be in English, one in Math, one in Science, one in Social Studies, and one in PE/Health.

To be admitted to OWE, students must be at least 16 years of age and have attempted two years of high school. These students may be admitted to technical programs when they meet the above enrollment guidelines.

Early graduation is not available.
