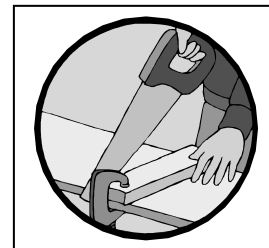


**CARPENTRY**  
 (Supply Costs for 2010-2011 School Year)

**NOTE: The Career Center will provide one pair of Safety Glasses for each student.**

**STUDENT TOOL KIT NEEDED TO START THE CARPENTRY PROGRAM:**

1. Carpenter's tool box with hasp.
2. Leather nail and tool bag.
3. Crow's foot nail puller
4. 8" Tri-square with 1-9/16" blade if possible.
5. 16 oz. Or 20 oz. Straight claw hammer with a steel handle
6. 20' or 25' tape rule.
7. Flat pry bar (Stanley Wonder Bar or equal).
8. Set of straight screwdrivers
9. Set of Phillips screwdrivers, #1, #2, #3.
10. Nylon filled chalk line and reel. (The nylon refill might have to be purchased separately).
11. Metal Speed Square
12. Nail set.
13. 4" Shur-form File
14. Aluminum framing square.
15. Hard Hart
16. Red, green and yellow aviation tin snips
17. Brass Stair Layout Buttons for use on Framing Square



**NOTES:**

1. Students will be required to purchase the following: One pair of steel-toed safety shoes, work clothes, 1 eyeglass holder, 2 locks (one for their locker and one for the tool box).
2. Quality tools are recommended.
3. The student will be responsible for reimbursing the school for the following items that will become the student's personal property:
