

# **NATURAL RESOURCES/HEAVY EQUIPMENT**

(Supply Costs for 2012-2013 School Year)

**NOTE: The Career Center will provide one pair of Safety Glasses for each student.**

## **EQUIPMENT AND UNIFORMS NEEDED BY STUDENTS STARTING THE FORESTRY/NATURAL RESOURCES PROGRAM:**

- A. All students will be required to purchase the following:
1. One pair leather boots. Gortex and at least 200 grains of Thinsulate liner and steel toes are recommended. (They are much warmer for winter work.) At least one set of work clothes and boots which will be kept in lockers at all times.
  2. 1 – 8-1/2 x 11 blue standard size binder with 100 sheets of lined 8-1/2 x 11, 3-hole paper. One set index dividers for notebook (12). Three pencils.
  3. One pair leather works gloves.
  4. One pair winter coveralls, long sleeve, Carhart brand recommended.
  5. Water jug. A water container is required for field work.
  6. Individualized lab project approved by the parents and the instructor.
  7. Wristwatch.
- B. 1. **The student will be responsible for reimbursing the school for the following items that will become the student's personal property:**

### PLEASE NOTE:

1. At various times during the year, students are assigned Washington County Career Center equipment to use. (Example – hard hats, cruising sticks and Doyle Scales). If the equipment is lost, damaged or destroyed due to negligence, the student will be expected to pay for the equipment.
2. Equipment inspections are held regularly throughout the year. Students are expected to have all safety equipment in lockers at all times.
