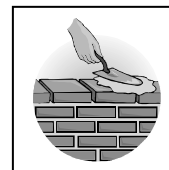


MASONRY

TOOLS

Student tool kit needed to start the Masonry Trades Program:

- 1 Tool Box (lockable) Width – 8” Height – 8” or 10”, length – 20” or 22”
- 1 Brick Trowel 5” x 10-1/2” or 5” x 11”
- 1 4’ Wooden Level
- 1 2’ Wooden Level
- 1 Brick Hammer 12-16 oz.
- 1 Convex Jointer (Striking Iron) 5/8 x 3/4 x 3/4 x 7/8
- 1 6’ Modular Rule
- 1 Raking tool
- 1 Chalk Box
- 1 Wire Brush
- 1 Foxtail Brush or Bench Brush

NOTES:

- 1. We highly recommend the American level or any wooden level, brass bound.
- 2. Students will be required to purchase the following: Steel-toed safety shoes, and a **lock** for their **tool box**.
- 3. **The student will be responsible for reimbursing the school for the following items that will become the student’s personal property:**
