WCCC Ag & Industrial Equipment Scholarship - \$1,000.00

- Must be a graduating student of a Washington County Public High School and is planning to continue his/her training by enrolling in a 1 to 4-year post-secondary institution majoring in Agricultural, Industrial or Heavy Truck Equipment.
- Applicants must have attained a minimum cumulative high school 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 grading scale.
- Two confidential rating forms and recommendation letters are to be completed by one academic teacher, and if applicable, one vocational teacher.
- All applicants are required to submit an essay reflecting upon their desire to work in the Agricultural, Industrial or Heavy Equipment/Truck field and to outline their career goals.
- Applications must be completed and submitted to the WCCC Guidance Department by April 15, 2010.
- The scholarship may be used for any costs directly related to educational expenses (i.e. tuition, books, lab fees, tools, room & board, etc.)
- Upon receipt of proof of acceptance by the post secondary institution, monies will be paid directly to the educational institution after July 1 of the year awarded. Payment will be made directly to the vendor, if monies are to be used to purchase tools.

The committee will include: Three current Advisory Board members or former students of the Ag Mechanics & Power Equipment program, one WCCC administrator, one WCCC school counselor and one Washington County JVS District board member.
