WorkKeys scores to be considered for admissions must be obtained at least three days prior to the start of a program. There are three possible outcomes after taking WorkKeys:

- 1. Receive a remediation-free score in each of the three categories indicating admission into the program after all other registration requirements have been met.
- 2. Score within one point of a cut score with an asterisk indicated. In this instance, individuals can either (A) be waitlisted and retest (at least three days prior to the first day of the program) to attempt a remediation-free score or (B) be admitted into a program with their current score (within one point of the cut score where an asterisk is indicated) and follow remediation plan through Aspire office.
- 3. Score <3 (less than three), within one point of a cut score <u>without</u> an asterisk indicated, or two or more points away from the cut score. In this instance, individuals can either (A) retest (at least three days prior to the first day of the program) to attempt a higher score or (B) follow a remediation plan through Aspire office and retest (at least three days prior to the first day of the program) when ready.

After registering for a program, students must meet required scores before being admitted to the program unless:

- 1. An asterisk (*) indicates admission into programs if within one point of cut score and student consents to Aspire referral and follows remediation plan through Success class or KeyTrain. Or:
- 2. Students pursuing Adult Diploma Program should consult with Aspire/Ohio Options Coordinator to discuss WorkKeys benchmark scores and timelines of obtainment of scores.
