SUB REQUIREMENTS

Ohio Department of Education (ODE)

1. SHORT-TERM SUBSTITUTE LICENSE

This license may be issued to the holder of a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution of higher education. An individual holding a short-term substitute license may teach in a given classroom for no more than 60 (school) days during the current school year. For periods longer than 60 (school) days, an individual with a long-term substitute license must be employed.

2. LONG-TERM SUBSTITUTE LICENSE

A long-term substitute license may be issued to the holder of a baccalaureate degree who has evidence of appropriate coursework as follows:

Career-Tech Workforce Development – The district e-signer must verify with his or her electronic signature in the online license system that the applicant has the necessary skills and/or education to serve in the teaching field requested.
