DIRECTOR/ INSTRUCTOR

Candidates must have three (3) years of experience in the EMS field. Possess or qualify for a career-technical education license or adult education permit through the Ohio Department of Education. Possess a valid certificate to practice in Ohio as an EMS provider at the EMR, EMT, AEMT, or Paramedical Level. Maintain EMS certificates as outlined in the Ohio Administrative Code. Shall possess and maintain a valid EMS Instructor's Certification issued by the Ohio Department of Public Safety Division of EMS is required.

Under the direction of the Medical Programs Manager, the EMS Program Director, is responsible for overseeing EMS continuing education program design, curriculum development, training delivery, student records, examinations, program statistical data collection, and assisting quality assurance of EMS field providers performing protocols correctly. Participate in quality improvement as a component of measuring training quality and needs.
